

# Creating Your Summer Story

**Description:** What better way to remember the summer by creating a summer story. Work as a family to develop the story and write different parts of it. Have fun with it by taking your favorite summer experience and making a fictional story!

## **Steps:**

1. Decide as a family what story you would like to tell or what parts of the summer you would like to combine to make a story

3. Assign which family member will be responsible for each part of creating the story. Example roles can be; writers, illustrators, editors.
