

# The Magic of Memory



**Description:** Practice essential elements of English, language arts, and math using the game of memory.

Students will have a blast racing against each other to make the most matches!

## How to Play:

1. Choose letters, numbers, shapes, site words, colors, or anything else that you would like to use as a review for students.
2. Write your review item on one side of the paper plate. Be sure to make two of each item chosen. For example, if you chose shapes then you should draw a triangle on two plates.
3. When you are ready to play, mix the plates up and place them face down side by side to form a square. Have students pick one at a time to make a match. If the match is made, they win the plates.

## Variations:

- Place numbers on each plate and have students complete a math equation for the two numbers they have flipped over.
- Place spelling or vocabulary words on each plate and once the match is made, have students use the words in a sentence or give the synonym or antonym.
