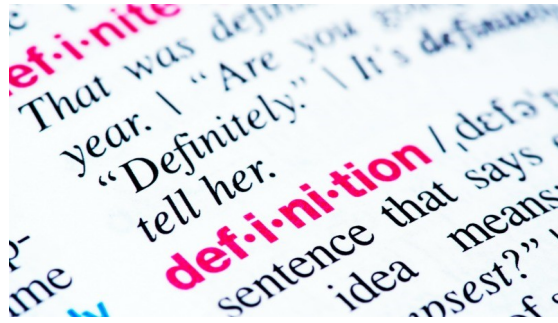


Vocabulary Word Jar
